OVERVIEW: Branson, Missouri is located in southwest Missouri, 35 miles south of Springfield on U.S. 65. Built on a ridge, Branson provides spectacular views of the surrounding mountains. It is ranked 25th for overnight leisure vacation destinations in the country. Tourism is the primary growth industry in Branson. The city has many services that equal or surpass larger urban areas and can handle the needs of the eight million annual visitors traveling here.

THEATERS/SHOWS: The Branson/Lakes Area has dozens of theaters with 57,000+ seats (more than Broadway) and 100 different live shows each season. Audiences can enjoy seeing shows throughout the day with morning, matinee and evening performances. Country, pop, swing, rock 'n' roll, gospel, classical and Broadway-style musical productions join comedy, acrobatics and magic shows to provide visitors with a wide array of entertainment choices.

LAKES: Table Rock, Taneycomo and Bull Shoals are three pristine lakes with over 1,000 miles of shoreline offering fishing, boating, parasailing, jet skiing, scuba diving, swimming and more. While the lakes all offer great fishing, each has its specialty. Table Rock Lake offers world-class bass fishing; Lake Taneycomo, with its cold waters, offers superb trout fishing; and Bull Shoals Lake is a warm water angler's paradise, especially known for tournament bass fishing.
